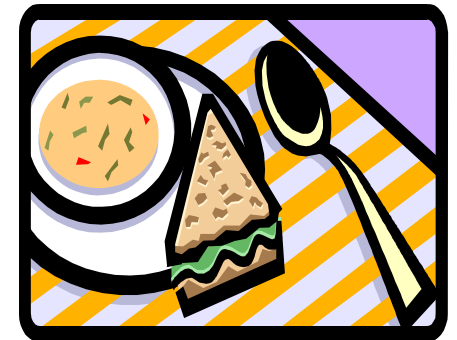

What is the Child and Adult Care Food Program?

The Child and Adult Care Food Program provides resources for feeding children and youth.

Homeless, runaway, and domestic violence shelters are eligible to receive Child and Adult Care Food Program funds for meals and snacks served to children and youth.

The Child and Adult Care Food Program is an equal opportunity program administered by the Texas Health and Human Services Commission.



How can the program help your shelter?

- ◆ When your shelter participates in the food program, the Texas Health and Human Services Commission will reimburse you for the healthy meals and snacks served to children and youth.
- ◆ Your shelter will be eligible to receive up to \$6.66 per day, per child.
- ◆ Shelters serving meals to 20 children and youth each day could be eligible to receive up to \$48,000 a year in food program reimbursements.



Who can participate?

Children and youth 18 years or younger and disabled persons of any age residing in a homeless shelter.



What sites are eligible?

- ◆ Homeless Shelters
- ◆ Domestic Violence Shelters
- ◆ Family Shelters
- ◆ Youth Serving Shelters
- ◆ Crisis Shelters
